

Extract from Resolution No. 211/2013 of the CEO of the Budapest Stock Exchange Ltd

The Chief Executive Officer of the Budapest Stock Exchange Ltd. (hereinafter: Exchange) declares that the Reference Price of the ordinary shares, ISIN HU0000122098, of the issuer **NORDTELEKOM Telecommunications Service Provider Public Limited Company** (registered seat: 1074 Budapest, Dohány u. 12-14, hereinafter: Issuer) for the Exchange Day May 22, 2013 shall be determined based on the value of the Closing Price on the Exchange Day May 17, 2013 of the ordinary shares, ISIN HU0000099239, divided by one hundred.

The value of the Reference Price for the Exchange Day May 22, 2013 is determined to be 18 HUF in accordance with the rounding rules and the tick size of the ordinary shares, ISIN HU0000122098.

According to Section 9.6.c) of the Code of Trading of the Budapest Stock Exchange orders in the Order Book of ordinary shares, ISIN HU0000099239, which are not expired or cancelled until the end of Exchange Day May 21, 2013 shall be cancelled by the Exchange at the end of the respective Exchange Day (May 21, 2013). The last effective trading day of ordinary shares, ISIN HU0000099239, is May 21, 2013.

The Reference Price of the ordinary shares, ISIN HU0000122098, for the Exchange Day of May 22, 2013 shall be determined based on the value of the Closing Price of the ordinary shares ISIN HU0000099239 on the Exchange Day May 17, 2013 because based on Resolution No. 208/2013 of the Chief Executive Officer of the Exchange the trading of shares ISIN HU0000099239 was suspended from the beginning until the end of the Exchange Day May 21, 2013.
